Sale Terms and Conditions

1. All ponies consigned must be registered POA ponies.
2. **Deadline for entries is May 15, 2007**
Early Entry Fee \$75 if postmarked by May 15, 2007
Regular Entry Fee \$100 if postmarked by May 23, 2007
Late Entry Fee \$125 after May 23, 2007 up until sale time.
3. The Utah POAC, its officers and directors, act strictly and solely as commissioned agents and will not be liable for any disagreement between buyer and seller. All representation and warranties on any pony offered for sale is strictly and solely between the seller and buyer.
4. A recent photo of each POA consigned must accompany entry form. This picture will be used in a sale catalog in booklet form and on the internet site. No ponies will be accepted without a recent photo. All entries will be screened and the committee will select the best possible stock, keeping in mind a balanced number of animals by age, sex and color, breeding and show records and will try to accommodate as many consignors as possible.
5. If photos and write up of a registered POA reference sire is desired, send photo and \$20.00 fee for each stallion.
6. A stall fee of \$25.00 per day must accompany entry form if ponies are entered in the sale only. All ponies are expected to be stalled the night before the sale.
7. If pony is entered in the National Promo Show or Western Classic you will pay the stall fee with those shows.
8. Enclose registration, breeding certificate if bred mare, signed Transfer, **Owner's statement of fifty words or less** and entry fees with your entry blank. These will be returned to you if your entry is not accepted by the Screening Committee. Each pony brought to the Sale must have individual health papers and a negative Coggins test within 6(six) months of the Sale date.
9. All ponies accepted must be offered for sale in the auction ring.
10. A good halter and lead rope must go with each pony sold
11. All ponies will be inspected for POA color and height. Registered ID ponies will be sold at the end of the sale. Ponies that do not pass the height or color inspection can be sold at the end of the sale.
12. Any pony on which no starting bid is received from the audience at the Sale will be started by the auctioneer for \$200.00. If no raises or additional bids are received, it will be considered as a no-sale and the pony will remain the property of the consignor. All fees which have been paid will be forfeited.
13. Extra wood shavings will be available
14. **The sale will be limited to 25 head of approved sale ponies.**
15. If all sale papers are not in order and in time a **\$25 late fee** will be added.
16. Advertising will be done locally in Utah, Arizona, California and in other western states and in the National POA magazine.
17. There is no Pass Out Fee.

I herewith consign the above animals(s) to the Sale and agree in consideration of being allowed to offer my animal or animals for sale that I hereby release Spanish Fork City Fairgrounds and also release the Utah State POAC, its officers and members and associated clubs from any damages and injuries that might occur to my self, my family, or my animals while on the Sale grounds.

I further agree to pay the commission 10(ten) percent of the purchase price of any animal I sell at the Sale, whether it is sold privately on the grounds or publicly through the auction and give the Sale Committee the right to arrange my Sale entries in the selling order they deem most attractive and proper and abide by the Sale Committee rules and regulations and agree the Sale Committee will have the right to screen and reject my entries if they have obtained their quota, or feel they lack sufficient quality.
